**THE MARINE RAIDERS SALUTE THE 10<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF MARSOC**



*The Marine Raider/MARSOC Knife; limited edition of only 100. Ten percent (10%) of the knife sales price goes to the USMRA.*

- Authorized by the U.S. Marine Raider Association. Fundraiser: Ten percent (10%) of sales price of each knife goes to the U.S. Marine Raider Association.
- Limited Edition of only 100.
  - Serial No. 1 – Auctioned at the 2016 Raider Reunion Auction (100% of proceeds presented to Raider Association).
  - Serial No. 2 – Being presented to the U.S. Marine Raider Museum, aboard MCB Quantico.
  - Serial No. 3 – Presented, during the Reunion, to MARSOC/Raider HQ at MCB Camp Lejeune, for display in their glass Historical Showcase.
  - Serial No. 4 – To be presented to 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Raider Battalion HQ (West Coast) for display in their glass Historical Showcase, aboard Camp Pendleton.
- The Knife: KA-BAR/Ek 44 (which was the old Model 4, the basis of the prior Ek/MARSOC Presentation Knife). “Battle-Proven in Six Wars”™. Made by KA-BAR in Olean, N.Y., U.S.A.
- Inscription Engraved on Blade:
 

THE U.S. MARINE RAIDERS SALUTE THE

- Also Engraved on Blade: Raiders’ “Death’s-Head” patch.

- Knife Grips – Ek ergonomically scalloped; Black; Fracture-resistant Textured, Glass-Filled Nylon.
- Blade Steel Type: KA-BAR’s High Carbon 1095 Cro-Van Steel.
  - Blade Type: Double-edged; Spearpoint
  - Finish: Military Parkerized
  - Sharpness: *Razor Sharp!*
  - Blade Length: 6.625”
  - Full-Length, Full-Width Tang.



*Optional Display Case of American Dark Oak, with locking glass lid. Wall mounts included. 6” x 16” x 2”. The liner is O.D., for the World War II Raiders, and Desert Tan, for today’s Raiders.*

- Knife Overall Length: 12.625”.
- Crossguard: Steel; Military Parkerized; “S”-type; 2 ¼”.
- Grip Fasteners: Ek “X-Head” Fasteners; Custom-made, lathe-turned Steel; Military Parkerized; ½” O.D.
- Lanyard/Wrist Strap: Braided; Parachute Cord in Desert Tan Camo (representing the present-day Marine Raiders), and O.D. Parachute Cord (standing for the World War II “Founding Father” Marine Raiders), both permanently and symbolically intertwined.
- Knife Serial No.: Stamped on Brass Oval Disc, representative of the World War II Marine Raider Identification Disk (i.e. “Dog Tag”); affixed through the Lanyard/Wrist Strap. Each is hand ground to the proper shape and dimensions, using a WWII original as the pattern. This is a “First” with any military collectible.
- Certification Certificate: Included; Serially Numbered (001 – 100); Signed by President, U.S. Marine Raider Association and President, U.S. Marine Raider Foundation.
- Sheath (*included*): Celcon® Sheath; Black; with web gear belt loop and hilt snap strap; puncture-resistant

polymer body, which self-locks the knife in place; tie-down points; made by KA-BAR.

- Knife (with Sheath) Price: Only \$199.
- Display Case (Optional): Dark American Oak; Locking Glass Lid; displays flat or upright on shelf or mantel; with wall-hanging provisions. Price: Only \$59.

- Payment: All major Credit Cards; PayPal; Checks.
- Shipping: UPS (within CONUS/48) Please add:
